## *All in for Education - 2026 Annual National Theme*

**Q:** What are the guidelines for purchasing a gift card for an event?

**A:** Gift cards can be purchased as part of a care package, for members to hold a drawing or to enhance your activities. Do not use your entire service project budget on gift cards, use your best judgement for what is appropriate given your chapter or club funds.

**Q:** Are events for teachers only, or can school support staff be included and/or celebrated as well?

**A:** School support staff may be included, recognized and celebrated!

**Q:** Can matching funds be used to support a school?

**A:** Yes, schools qualify for matching funds. Partner with an existing fundraiser that is supporting a need for your school.

**Q:** Would a first aid educational event for members be counted toward an event for the theme?

**A:** Yes, as long as the event touches the lives of students or school staff, there is flexibility in the type of event. School open houses, community nights or after-school clubs are all ways to host this kind of event.

**Q:** Can events support the same school with different activities throughout the year?

**A:** Yes, the same school can be supported throughout the year. Be conscious to spread your support around to different classrooms and school staff.

**Q:** What is the best way to support home schoolers and Home School Associations?

**A:** Some communities host classes that all home schooled students may take, look into those settings. You can also connect with home school co-ops and other community groups that support these students to see how you can get involved.

**Q:** Will there be new supplies coming out for the 2026 annual theme?

**A:** No, there will not be new supplies coming out. There are a number of school-related supplies already on the list, many of which are free!

**Q:** Are reimbursement amounts for social activities increasing from \$2.50/member in 2026?

**A:** Social activity reimbursements will not change in 2026.

**Q:** When will Money & Me, the Money Masters replacement, be available?

**A:** The Fraternal Dept will have detailed updates for the Money & Me release this spring. There will be curriculum for students in kindergarten through 8<sup>th</sup> grade. There will not be a program for high school or adults.
